



# TEACHING IN THE LORD'S WAY

So anyone that knows me knows that I despise tomatoes with a deep passion. But one of the many things you must do on a mission is eat the food in front of you. So a member gave us a slice of tomato to eat and as I ate it, I loved it! Hooper tomatoes truly are amazing!

So it has been a really amazing week! We had our first baptism with Kenan! It was a lot of work getting him to the waters of baptism but the joy that came from his baptism was so worth it! He is going to be an amazing member! We are teaching about 6 people right now and they are all amazing! The thing that was a little hard to get used to was people all progressing at different rates. As a missionary you just want them all to get baptized at once but that never happens.

I am truly thankful for my time in the Utah Ogden mission. I know that the Lord sent me here for a specific reason. One of those reasons was to build my confidence. My confidence in myself and in my teaching has grown a large amount throughout these last six weeks. I am so thankful for that, but like Ammon I do not boast of my own strength because I know that without the Lord I am nothing. If any of you reading this are con-sidering a mission, or coming back to church or taking a big step in your life I invite you to do one thing. Pray. Pray with earnest and with all your heart. Then after stay quiet and still for about a minute and just listen to your feelings. If you do this Heavenly Father will answer any question you have. We have done this with investigators and it has truly performed miracles for them. I love this work! I love my companion! I love the Lord!

### 8/21

My last week in Ogden has been a very busy one! There has been lots of work to do and lots of good that has been done. So I sprained my ankle of Friday. Don't worry I am doing just fine. It hurt really bad when it happened. What's with Rogers men and messing up their ankles? But it shouldn't be to long before I am going good. It won't keep me from going to New Zealand thankfully. I am really excited for New Zealand. I keep hearing all these amazing things about it. I feel so blessed that the Lord has trusted me to labor in such a beautiful part of His world. I gave a talk last week in the Hooper 1st ward and they always want us starting our talks talking about why we came on missions. I have started trying to follow the spirit more when I give talks, and I talked about how it's because of my dad's example that I have always wanted to go on a mission. Have an amazing week!

### 8/28

I made it safe and sound to NZ. It has been really great so far! It was a exhausting first few days but other than that it has been really great! My companions name is Elder Tuione! He is from Tonga and he is a really cool guy. We get along really well. I am right now in South Auckland. That is where a lot of the Tongan people live. They are an amazing people who are feeding me way too much food. I am going to be so fat by the time that I get home. It has been a bit of a hard week with the whole language barrier. It was hard accepting at first that I wasn't going to all of a sudden be perfect at this language. I know it is going to take a lot of time and diligence and trusting in the Lord. I feel so blessed to be serving at this time and in this place. It truly is amazing.

It has been a crazy week! The weather is cold and rainy almost all days here. It was a little gloomy at first but it grows on you. I can't wait because the summer is right around the corner! The food is supper good except that the people are feeding me so much of it! The airline food was actually not terrible! It tasted good overall. Love you all! Elder Rogers 9/1
